

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When can I visit the trail?

The trail is open daily, year-round, from sunrise to sunset.

Are there trash barrels along the trail?

No, the Corps has a carry in/carry out trash policy. Remember to take only photographs, and leave only footprints.

Can I bring my dog on the trail?

Yes, but it must be on a leash no longer than 6 feet. Please pick up after your dog.

Are bicycles allowed?

Yes. cyclists must be courteous and yield to hikers. All cyclists should wear helmets at all times.

Are off-road vehicles allowed?

No, the use of off road vehicles is prohibited along the trail and on all project lands.

Are horses allowed?

Yes, horses are allowed, however we ask that riders clean up after their horses and remove droppings from the trail.

All trail users should show courtesy to other trail users. Please clean up after your animals. Ride with caution and respect for others.

The *Brimfield Trail* is a section of the *Titanic Rail Trail* (www.titanictrail.org) that is planned to run from Palmer to Franklin.

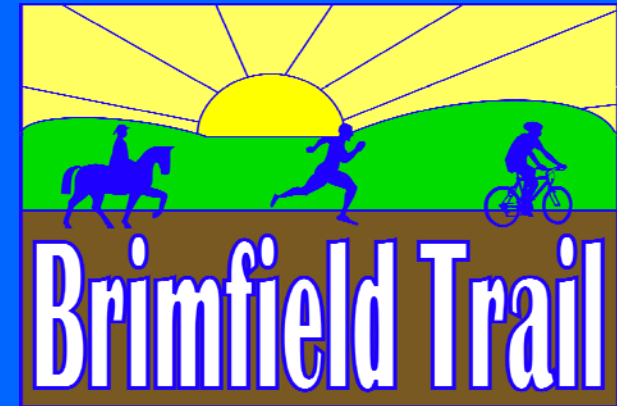
Currently, most of the trail runs on an old trolley rail bed which once operated between Springfield and Sturbridge.

The Trail is located on the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers managed land on the Quinebaug River flood control area. The hope is to continue the trail from it's current area to connect with the Grand Trunk Trail in Sturbridge at the East Brimfield Dam.

To the west side of the current section, the trail will continue to Brimfield Center and then toward Palmer.

You can access Five Bridge Road from either Route 20 across from Little Alum Road or off Holland Road in Brimfield.

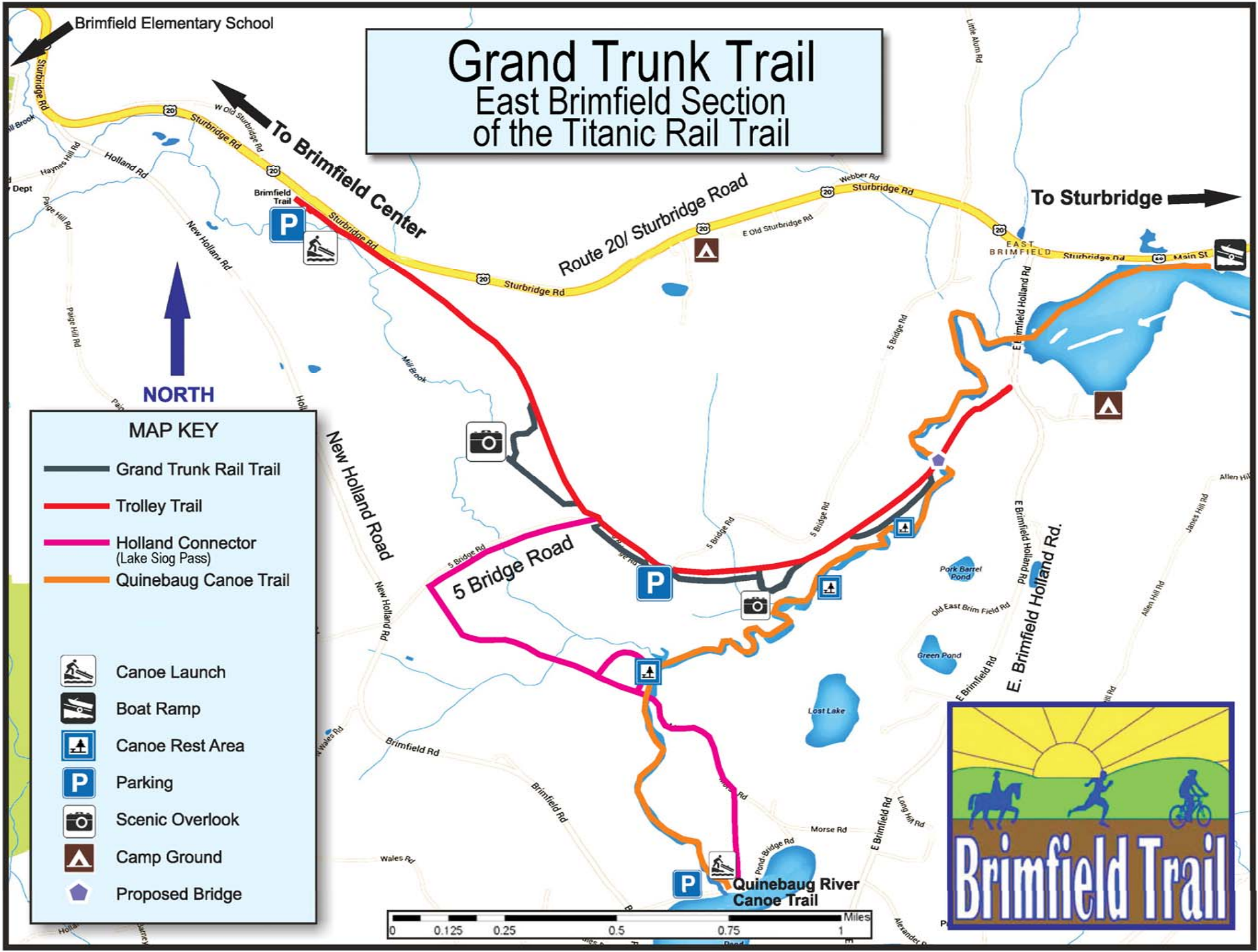
